



## Terms & Conditions

### Studio Term Time:

- New Students – Pay for one class at the casual price of \$20 (Preschool \$12), OR if you decide to continue, term fees apply.
- Term fees for Primary – Grade 5 \$125 per term / Intermediate & Seniors \$125 per term / Preschool \$80 per term. Fees must be paid by end of the first week of Term. A casual price of \$20 cash payment per class (Preschool \$12) will apply if payment is not received by the end of the first week of term.
- **No** refunds for non-attendance. Fees are for space reserved, not attendance base after the term has ended.
- **Private lessons** are \$90 per hour.
- **Uniform Requirements:** Ballet - Preschool to Grade 5: Navy blue leotard, tights, ballet shoes with cross elastics. Wrap around cardigan or fitting thermal top optional in Winter. Intermediate grade onwards, black leotard. Jazz – Navy blue leotard, black hot pants or leggings and jazz shoes. Grade 3 & up (MCJ) kneepads are compulsory. All uniform items can be ordered through the studio. Hair needs to be in a bun or plaits for ballet and in a ponytail or plaits for Jazz.
- Correspondence is via email. Students of Parents/Caregivers must subscribe to emails via the website.
- Further information and regular updates are on Facebook. Please like us on Facebook to receive these updates.
- We know we cannot always provide for all your dancing requirements at our Studio. However, it is required that you advise Peta if you are attending dance elsewhere as well as at our Studio. This is to avoid any conflict of instruction or clashes with performances or exams. **Please note** any student attending dance classes at the Studio may not attend the same of similar dance classes elsewhere unless in discussion first.

### Exams:

- **Dates** – Exams are always held in June and November each year *and are optional*. We cannot confirm the exact date until approximately one month out, as we are not advised of this date until then.
- **Registration fees** and all other cost for exam day, must be paid with registration. NO refunds as this is prepaid directly to the IDTA and we cannot receive a refund.
- **Exam Additional Classes** – If you choose to do the exams you must attend all additional classes relating to that exam. There will be approximately 6-8 weekend classes leading up to the exam – including Queen's Birthday Weekend and may also include 3-4 days in the holidays (usually second week).
- **Dancewear for the Exam** – Standard uniform is required. See your teacher for specifics.

## Show:

- **Participation Fee:** \$50 – Preschool / \$70 – up to Grade 5 / \$90 – Intermediate & over. Must be paid with registration. **NO REFUNDS!**
- **Show Rehearsals:** The Show is a big commitment for you, your family and everyone involved. We endeavour to keep rehearsals to a minimum. Participants are required to attend ALL rehearsals. If you have other commitments that conflict, please speak to your dance teacher BEFORE committing to the Show.
- **Information:** Your group will be assigned a coordinator who will be your first point of contact. We will make every effort to keep you updated with all information. However, if you are not at rehearsals it is up to you to find out if you have missed any information.
- **Dancewear for the show:** You are required to have the Studio standard uniform relevant to your grade, including ballet flats and jazz shoes. A Body stocking is required for Grade 2 and up. Seniors will be advised if pointe shoes are required. Costumes will be arranged once dance numbers are set and mostly from Studio costumes. However, some small items may be required to purchase by you. We try to keep this to an absolute minimum (i.e.) a t-shirt. You will be advised closer to the Show of specific requirements from your coordinator.
